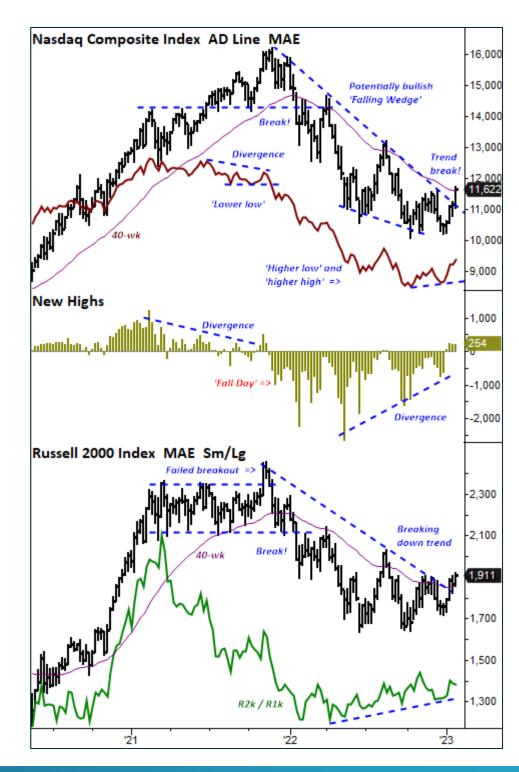
Breaking Downtrends

- Another good week for stocks
- Bulls 'have the ball' now moving it down field
- Internals strong, and building off divergences
- Small caps showing good relative strength
- 'Risk-on' sectors also strong & leading
- Now checking 'Step 3' of bottoming process

Bottoming Process

- ✓ Set initial low
- ✓ Bounce & test that low (can do so more than once)
- ☐ Follow-through to the upside
- Test the breakout successfully

Note: Process can fail & restart



Big Picture

Commodities / US\$:

- Commodities up 2x since Mar'20
- BCOM holding 110 area
- 'Stagflation' a very real worry

Yields / Credit:

- 10-yr. finding support in 3½% area
- Biggest yield curve inversion since 1981
- Corporate credit markets improving

Stocks:

- Have seen a typical 'bear market'
- Market internals improving dramatically
- Now breaking down trendlines (Step 3)
- Still a chance of secular bear
