Still Diverging??

- Another new high in S&P 500
- New cycle high in NASDAQ
- Still seeing divergences??
- In a bull market surprises typically come to the upside

Broadening

- Small & mid-caps successfully testing breakouts
- Chinese markets stabilizing
- Sentiment has been extreme (fund closures & headlines)



Big Picture

Commodities / US\$:

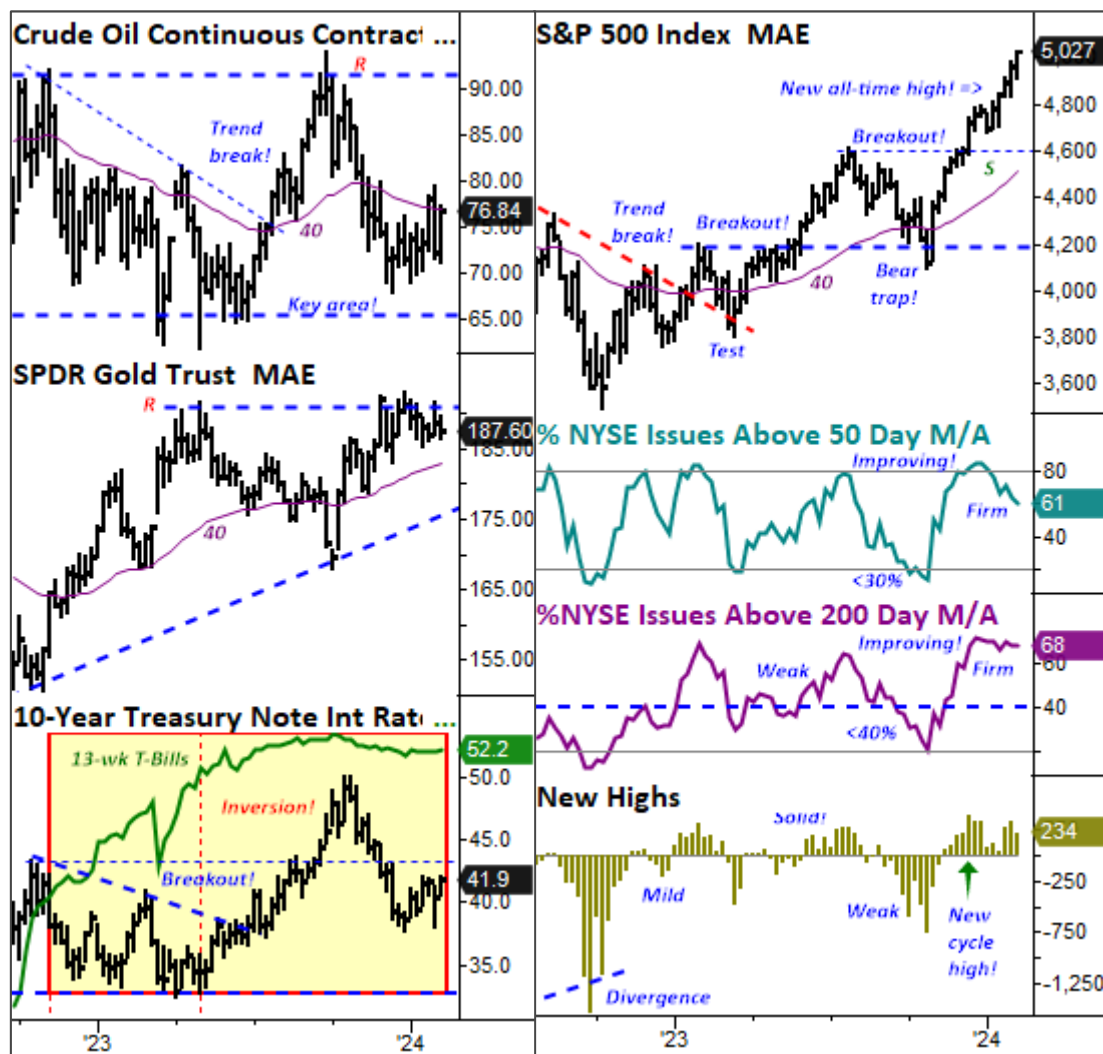
- BCOM struggling to hold support
- Crude holding key \$65 area
- Gold near highs – benefiting from unrest

Yields / Credit:

- 3-mo. T-Bills seeing support at 5.20%
- 10-yr. failed at 5%, and held 3¾%
- Yield curve inverted since Nov'22
- Reliable forecaster of recessions

Stocks:

- Saw a typical ‘bear market’ in 2022
- Now looks to be in typically ‘bull market’
- S&P 500 scoring new all-time highs
- Internals solid for this point in cycle

Commodities	--	Have seen a meaningful pullback; now testing important support
Bonds/Rates	▼ / ▲	Rates likely in secular uptrend, have potentially seen high for cycle
Stocks	▲	Saw a textbook bear & bottom; likely in middle innings of bull market
